Wound Management:

Post Operative Wound Management

- ❖ Post operative wounds progress through the phases of wound healing unless impaired by underlying patient conditions or environmental factors.
- ❖ Suture/ Staple Removal
- ❖ Drain Charging, Monitoring and Removal
- ❖ Burn management, pregraft wound care- debridment, post wound graft and graft site care.

Diabetic Foot Ulcers

Diabetic ulcers result from injury predisposed by underlying neuropathy and/or ischemia. Prevention of ulceration or recurrence is improved by educating clients and families about their role in the early identification and reduction of risk factors.

Oncology Wound Management

Disruptions to skin integrity related to cancer are due to either primary lesions, or secondary lesions, to metastatic spread. Wounds present many challenges.

Venous Insufficiency Leg Ulcer

The management of venous insufficiency ulcers requires the control of edema and infection, wound closure and vascular treatment.

Arterial Lower Extremity

Arterial ulcers are caused by insufficient arterial perfusion to the lower extremities. Disease often results from arteriosclerosis of vessel walls and atherosclerotic plaque accumulation causing vessel occlusion.

Pressure Ulcers

Also referred to as decubitus ulcers which generally occur over bony prominences. Pressure ulcers are classified into four classifications, depending on severity, and are generally caused by unrelieved pressure on the bodies' soft tissue.

Assessment /Monitoring/Charting/ Reporting

All clients and wounds are monitored closely for any signs of complications. Any concerns will be reported to the appropriate medical personal immediately. Comprehensive charting is maintained on each client's progress.
